also enter through area of dry, flaky skin or swollen skin.

Other factors:

Injury. Any fracture, burn or scrape gives bacteria an entry point.

Weakened immune system.

Skin conditions. Skin disorders-such as eczema, chicken-pox and shingles.

Chronic swelling of your arms or legs (lymph edema).

Start treatment early. In most cases, signs and symptoms of cellulitis disappears after treatment.

- If hospitalized, the treatments usually includes antibiotic for five to ten days or can possibly be up to two weeks.
- For most surface wounds, an over-the-counter antibiotic ointment such as Neosporin or Polysporin.
- For those with poor circulation: lubricating your skin with moisturizers helps prevent cracking and peeling.

Cellulitis

Cellulitis is a common, potentially serious bacterial skin infection. Cellulitis appears as a swollen, red area of skin that feels hot and tender. It can spread rapidly to other parts of the body. Cellulitis isn't usually spread from person to person. Skin on lower legs is most commonly affected, though cellulitis can occur anywhere in your body or face. Cellulitis might affect only your skin's surface. Or it might also affect tissues underlying your skin and can spread to your lymph nodes and bloodstream. Left untreated, the spreading infection can rapidly turn life-threatening once it enters the bloodstream. This occurs when you have a red, warm, swollen, tender and changing or expanding rash and you have a fever. It's important to seek immediate medical attention if cellulitis symptoms occur. Possible signs and symptoms of cellulitis, which usually occur on one side of the body include:

- Red areas of skin that tends to expand.
- Swelling.
- Tenderness.
- Pain.
- Warmth.
- Fever.
- Red spots.
- Blisters.
- Rash.
- Skin dimpling.

Cellulitis occurs when bacteria, most commonly streptococcus and staphylococcus, enter through a crack or break in your skin. The incidence of a more serious staphylococcus infection called Methicillin-Resistant Staphylococcus Aureus (MRSA) is increasing. Bacteria is most likely to enter disrupted areas of skin, such as where you've had recent surgery, cuts, puncture wounds, an ulcer, athlete's foot or dermatitis. Certain types of insect or spider bites also can transmit the bacteria that start the infection. Bacteria can

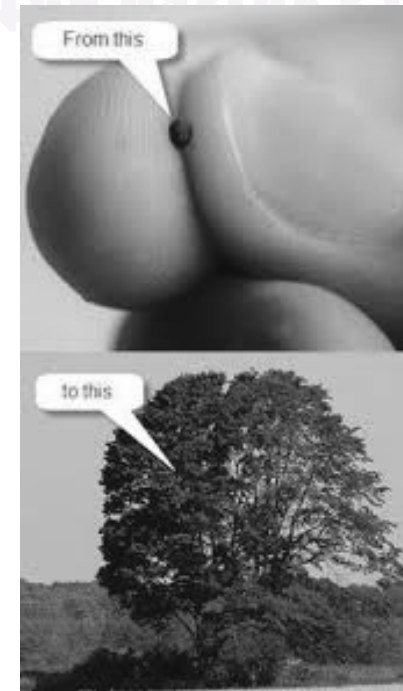
13:18, 19). Someone might ask, What is a mustard seed? It is a garden herb which in comparison to other herbs can grow until it becomes a large tree. The mustard seed is very small and it is black in color. Jesus used the parable of the mustard seed to illustrate the growth and development of the spiritual kingdom of God.

On the Day of Pentecost when the spiritual kingdom of God was established it had a very small beginning of only 120 souls (Acts 1:12-14) but it grew, and grew, and spread from Jerusalem, to all Judaea, and to Samaria, and to all of the Roman empire through the ministry of the Apostle Paul and other ministers who helped him (Acts 13:1-3). The spiritual kingdom of God continued to grow and develop. It spread to Europe, then to Canada, and finally to the United States of America. The spiritual kingdom of God came first to Topeka, Kansas in 1901, then to Orchard, Texas in 1905, and next to Los Angeles, California in 1906. The Pentecostal experience and the Apostolic Doctrine and Faith, and the establishment of the spiritual kingdom of God came to Cincinnati, Ohio in 1920. The mustard seed sown in Jerusalem in 33 AD has become a great large tree here in Cincinnati, Ohio; the invisible church of the living God where the saints can find food and shelter!

Let us look for and expect the same thing to happen again tonight, just like it did on the Day of Pentecost. (Acts 2:1-4) says = And when the day of Pentecost was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. And suddenly there came a sound from heaven as of a rushing mighty wind, and it filled all the house where they were sitting. And there appeared unto them cloven tongues like as of fire, and it sat upon each of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. This was the birth of the Apostolic Church, and the beginning of the spiritual kingdom of God which was invisible and was established in the hearts of the believers in Christ. When Jesus came to the earth the first time they thought he was going to establish an earthly kingdom and sit in Jerusalem on the throne of his father David. But Jesus came to bring salvation to the whole world and to establish a spiritual kingdom in the earth.

I have written this week with the Lord's help about the Growth and Development of the Spiritual Kingdom of God. The scripture text for this article comes from the Book of Matthew. This book was written by Matthew, the son of Alphaeus. He is also called Levi (Mark

2:14) (Luke 5:27). Matthew was a disciple and apostle of Jesus Christ (Matthew 9:9) and (Matthew 10:3). The Book of Matthew was written for all mankind in general, but to the Jews in particular. Matthew records twelve parables which Jesus taught concerning the spiritual kingdom of God. They are found in (Matthew 13:1-58) (Matthew 18:23-35) (Matthew 20:1-16) (Matthew 22:1-14) (Matthew 25:1-13) and (Matthew 25:14-30).

Each of these twelve parables give us insight and instructions concerning the nature, character, and influence of Christ's spiritual kingdom in the earth.

What is a parable? And why did Jesus teach in parables? A parable is an earthly story with a heavenly meaning. Also it is a natural story which teaches spiritual truth. Webster defines the word PARABLE as a short, simple story teaching a moral lesson. Jesus taught and used parables because the religious leaders of his day opposed him and tried to use his own words against him. He used parables to conceal truth from those who opposed him, and he used parables to reveal spiritual truth to his disciples.
